AN ACT CONCERNING THE DESIGNATION OF VARIOUS DAYS, WEEKS AND MONTHS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision (48) of subsection (a) of section 10-29a of the
- 2 2020 supplement to the general statutes is repealed and the following is
- 3 substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):
- 4 (48) [The Governor shall proclaim the Saturday that is closest to] June
- 5 nineteenth of each year [to] shall be observed in Connecticut as
- 6 Juneteenth Independence Day in recognition of the formal
- 7 emancipation of enslaved African-Americans pursuant to General
- 8 Order No. 3 of June 19, 1865, in Galveston, Texas. The Governor shall
- 9 annually designate this day with suitable proclamation or letter urging
- 10 that on Juneteenth Independence Day schools, civic organizations,
- 11 institutions of higher education, governmental departments and all
- 12 citizens and groups give serious thought to, and mark by appropriate
- 13 exercises of a public nature, the meaning and importance of the end of

- slavery in the United States and recognize and celebrate the importance
- of this day to every person who cherishes liberty and equality for all
- 16 people. Suitable exercises shall be held in the State Capitol and
- 17 elsewhere as the Governor designates for the observance of the day.
- Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of section 10-29a of the 2020 supplement to the
- 19 general statutes is amended by adding subdivisions (98) to (101),
- 20 inclusive, as follows (*Effective from passage*):
- 21 (NEW) (98) The Governor shall proclaim the month of September
- 22 annually to be Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month to heighten public
- 23 awareness of the associated presentation and available treatments for
- ovarian cancer. Suitable exercises may be held in the State Capitol and
- 25 elsewhere as the Governor designates for the observance of the month.
- 26 (NEW) (99) The Governor shall proclaim the week of November
- 27 thirteenth annually to be Kindness Week to promote acts of kindness
- among the residents of the state. Suitable exercises may be held in the
- 29 State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for the
- 30 observance of the week.
- 31 (NEW) (100) The Governor shall proclaim the Saturday immediately
- 32 following the fourth Thursday in November of each year to be Small
- 33 Business Saturday in recognition of the value small businesses provide
- 34 to the state and national economies. Suitable exercises may be held in
- 35 the State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for the
- 36 observance of the day.
- 37 (NEW) (101) The Governor shall proclaim the week beginning with
- 38 the third Monday of February of each year to be Connecticut
- 39 Entrepreneur Week to honor entrepreneurs of the state for their
- 40 innovative contributions to the state's economy. Suitable exercises may
- 41 be held in the State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates
- 42 for the observance of the week.
