AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE REIMBURSEMENT PARITY FOR PODIATRISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective January 1, 2023) No insurer, health care
- 2 center, hospital service corporation, medical service corporation,
- 3 fraternal benefit society or other entity that delivers, issues for delivery,
- 4 renews, amends or continues an individual or group health insurance
- 5 policy providing coverage of the type specified in subdivisions (1), (2),
- 6 (4), (11) and (12) of section 38a-469 of the general statutes in this state on
- 7 or after January 1, 2023, shall pay a reduced reimbursement to a licensed
- 8 health care provider who provides a covered benefit within such
- 9 provider's scope of practice solely because such provider is a podiatrist.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1 January 1, 2023 New section

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Statement of Purpose:

To provide that a health insurer shall not pay a reduced reimbursement to a licensed health care provider who provides a covered benefit within the provider's scope of practice solely because the provider is a podiatrist.
