AN ACT ELIMINATING THE RACE DESIGNATION ON MARRIAGE LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 46b-25 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2020*):
- 3 No license may be issued by the registrar until both persons have
- 4 appeared before the registrar and made application for a license. The
- 5 registrar shall issue a license to any two persons eligible to marry under
- 6 this chapter. The license shall be completed in its entirety, dated, signed
- 7 and sworn to by each applicant and shall state each applicant's name,
- 8 age, [race,] birthplace, residence, whether single, widowed or divorced
- 9 and whether under the supervision or control of a conservator or
- 10 guardian. The Social Security numbers of both persons shall be recorded
- in the "administrative purposes" section of the license. If the license is
- signed and sworn to by the applicants on different dates, the later date
- 13 shall be deemed the date of application.
