AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF NONCOMPETE CLAUSES IN PHYSICIAN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the use of
- 2 noncompete clauses in a physician employment contract and allow for
- 3 the award of reasonable attorneys' fees to any physician that
- 4 successfully challenges the enforcement of a noncompete clause in his
- 5 or her employment contract.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage physicians to work in Connecticut.
