## AN ACT REQUIRING NOTIFICATION OF A FAMILY MEMBER OF A PATIENT ADMITTED TO A HOSPITAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 19a-508a of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2020*):
- 3 Upon admitting a patient to a hospital, hospital personnel shall
- 4 promptly ask the patient whether the patient desires for his or her
- 5 physician and any family member to be notified of the hospital
- 6 admission. If the patient so desires, hospital personnel shall make
- 7 reasonable efforts to notify the physician and family member
- 8 designated by the patient of the patient's hospital admission as soon as
- 9 practicable, but not later than twenty-four hours after the patient's
- 10 request. For purposes of this section, "hospital" has the same meaning
- as provided in section 19a-490; and "physician" means a person licensed
- 12 under the provisions of chapter 370.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
