## AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTRONIC TICKETING AND TICKET RESALE MARKETPLACES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that: (1) The
- 2 operator of an entertainment ticketing marketplace doing business in
- 3 this state shall (A) clearly disclose to a consumer, before the consumer
- 4 purchases a ticket on such marketplace, any fee such operator will
- 5 charge to the consumer for such purchase, and (B) not charge a delivery
- 6 fee for any ticket provided to a consumer by electronic means; and (2)
- 7 the operator of an entertainment ticket resale marketplace doing
- 8 business in this state shall (A) disclose the original price of a ticket resold
- 9 on such marketplace, and (B) adhere to professional standards by,
- among other things, maintaining a physical place of business.

## Statement of Purpose:

To impose various duties on operators of entertainment ticketing marketplaces and entertainment ticket resale marketplaces doing business in this state.
