**AN ACT CONCERNING CYBERBULLYING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require each social media
- 2 provider doing business in this state to: (1) Enforce minimum age
- 3 requirements for persons using such provider's social media platform;
- 4 (2) develop content filters for younger users to curb cyberbullying on
- 5 such provider's social media platform; and (3) agree to any choice of law
- 6 provision contained in a user agreement that would subject such
- 7 provider to liability in this state for damages incurred by a person in this
- 8 state due to cyberbullying on such provider's social media platform.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To establish additional protections against cyberbullying on social media platforms.
