AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS TO OFFER PATIENTS A TEST FOR HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS AT LEAST ONCE ANNUALLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require health care providers
- 2 to offer their patients a test for human immunodeficiency virus as least
- 3 once annually.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase testing, protect members of the public and decrease the stigma surrounding a test for human immunodeficiency virus.
