AN ACT PROHIBITING THE STATE FROM MANDATING A VACCINE THAT HAS ONLY BEEN GIVEN EMERGENCY USE AUTHORIZATION FROM THE FEDERAL FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the state of
- 2 Connecticut from mandating a vaccine that only has been given
- 3 emergency use authorization from the federal Food and Drug
- 4 Administration.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that long-term vaccine studies are performed on a vaccine before the vaccine is mandated by the state.
