## AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE ACCESSIBILITY OF STATE BUILDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective July 1, 2020) The Department of Administrative
- 2 Services shall examine the accessibility of buildings owned and leased
- 3 by the state to people with disabilities. Not later than January 1, 2021,
- 4 the department shall submit a report on such examination and any
- 5 recommendations to improve such accessibility, in accordance with the
- 6 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing
- 7 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
- 8 relating to public safety and security.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
