## AN ACT CONCERNING WEED MAPPING ON CANDLEWOOD LAKE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 14-21aa of the 2020 supplement to the general
- 2 statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
- 3 (*Effective October 1, 2020*):
- 4 (a) There is established an account to be known as the "Connecticut
- 5 Lakes, Rivers and Ponds Preservation account". The Connecticut Lakes,
- 6 Rivers and Ponds Preservation account shall be a separate, nonlapsing
- 7 account of the General Fund. Any moneys required by law to be
- 8 deposited in the account shall be deposited in and credited to the
- 9 Connecticut Lakes, Rivers and Ponds Preservation account. The account
- 10 shall be available to the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental
- 11 Protection for (1) restoration and rehabilitation of lakes, rivers and
- 12 ponds in the state; (2) programs of the Department of Energy and
- 13 Environmental Protection for the eradication of aquatic invasive species
- 14 and cyanobacteria blooms; (3) education and public outreach programs
- 15 to enhance the public's understanding of the need to protect and
- preserve the state's lakes, rivers and ponds; (4) allocation of grants to

- 17 state and municipal agencies and not-for-profit organizations to
- 18 conduct research and to provide public education and public awareness
- 19 to enhance understanding and management of the natural resources of
- 20 the state's lakes, rivers and ponds; (5) provision of funds for all services
- 21 that support the protection and conservation of the state's lakes, rivers
- 22 and ponds; and (6) reimbursement of the Department of Motor Vehicles
- 23 for the cost of producing, issuing, renewing and replacing Save Our
- 24 Lakes commemorative number plates, including administrative
- 25 expenses, pursuant to section 14-21z.
- 26 (b) The commissioner may receive private donations to the
- 27 Connecticut Lakes, Rivers and Ponds Preservation account and any
- such receipts shall be deposited in the account.
- 29 (c) The commissioner may provide for the reproduction and
- 30 marketing of the Save Our Lakes commemorative number plate image
- 31 for use on clothing, recreational equipment, posters, mementoes, or
- 32 other products or programs deemed by the commissioner to be suitable
- as a means of supporting the Connecticut Lakes, Rivers and Ponds
- 34 Preservation account. Any funds received by the commissioner from
- 35 such marketing shall be deposited in the Connecticut Lakes, Rivers and
- 36 Ponds Preservation account.
- 37 (d) Notwithstanding any provision of this section, not less than
- 38 eighty per cent of any funds deposited into the Connecticut Lakes,
- 39 Rivers and Ponds Preservation account pursuant to section 14-21bb
- 40 shall be utilized for the purposes described in subdivisions (2) to (4),
- 41 inclusive, of subsection (a) of this section.
- 42 (e) Notwithstanding any provision of this section, for the fiscal year
- 43 commencing July 1, 2020, and for each fiscal year thereafter, the
- 44 commissioner shall provide the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars
- 45 from the Connecticut Lakes, Rivers and Ponds Preservation account to
- 46 the Connecticut Agricultural Experimentation Station for the purpose of
- 47 collecting and analyzing data concerning the growth of aquatic invasive
- 48 species in Candlewood Lake in order to understand and document the

- 49 growth and diminishment of such invasive species in Candlewood Lake
- and recommend measures to be taken by the state and municipalities
- 51 <u>that border Candlewood Lake to minimize such growth.</u>

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following		
sections:
