AN ACT PREVENTING THE SOCIAL ISOLATION OF SENIOR CITIZENS WHO RESIDE IN NURSING HOMES AND RESPECTING THEIR RIGHTS TO FAMILY CONTACT AND PRIVACY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prevent the social isolation
- 2 of senior citizens residing in nursing homes and respect their dignity by
- 3 implementing steps including, but not limited to: (1) Guaranteeing such
- 4 senior citizens the right to communicate with their families and other
- 5 persons they wish to see in the manner they choose, (2) allowing such
- 6 senior citizens zones of privacy, and (3) requiring nursing homes to treat
- 7 residential space allotted to such senior citizens as their homes, rather
- 8 than treating them as occupants.

Statement of Purpose:

To enhance the bill of rights for senior citizens residing in nursing homes.
