AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY REGARDING CAMERA VIDEO SYSTEMS INSIDE SCHOOL BUSES AND STUDENT TRANSPORTATION VEHICLES USED TO TRANSPORT STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Education
2 shall study issues related to the installation of camera video systems
3 inside school buses and student transportation vehicles used to
4 transport students with special needs and make recommendations
5 regarding the installation and operation of such systems and the
6 storage, security and use of recordings. Not later than January 1, 2020,
7 the commissioner shall submit the results of such study and any
8 recommendations, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a
9 of the general statutes, to the joint standing committees of the General
10 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to education and
11 transportation.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
