**AN ACT CONCERNING A REVIEW AND ANALYSIS OF STATE REVENUE COLLECTION PROCESSES AND METHODOLOGIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Revenue  
2 Services shall review and analyze the revenue collection processes and  
3 methodologies used by the Department of Revenue Services, to identify  
4 programmatic and legislative changes that may be made to streamline  
5 and improve the efficiency of such collections. Not later than January 1,  
6 2021, the commissioner shall submit a report, in accordance with the  
7 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, on the commissioner's  
8 findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee of the  
9 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to finance,  
10 revenue and bonding.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
