AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF DRUG TREATMENT SERVICES AT CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 325 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Correction to: (1) Increase bed capacity at
- 3 correctional facilities that offer drug treatment services, and (2)
- 4 develop and implement policies that minimize the time an inmate has
- 5 to wait for drug treatment services upon discharge from a correctional
- 6 facility.

Statement of Purpose:

To minimize the disruption of timely drug treatment services to inmates suffering from drug addiction.
