**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TAX CREDIT FOR BUSINESSES THAT
OFFER STUDENT LOAN REPAYMENT TO GRADUATES OF
INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND PRIVATE
OCCUPATIONAL SCHOOLS IN THE STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a tax credit for
- 2 businesses that provide student loan repayment assistance to
- 3 employees who earned their bachelor's degree, associate degree or
- 4 certificate from a public institution of higher education, independent
- 5 nonprofit institution of higher education or private occupational
- 6 school in the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a tax credit for businesses that provide student loan
repayment assistance to graduates of institutions of higher education
and private occupational schools in the state.
