AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF CERTAIN ALTERNATIVE TREATMENT SEPTIC SYSTEMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective October 1, 2020) (a) Notwithstanding any 2 provision of the Public Health Code or title 19a, 22a or 25 of the general 3 statutes, the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection shall 4 authorize the use of alternative treatment septic systems if the use of 5 such system: (1) Replaces an existing failing septic system, (2) does not 6 allow for the further subdivision of the subject property, (3) does not 7 result in an increase in the number of bedrooms for any dwelling or 8 improvement upon such subject property, and (4) the Commissioner of 9 Energy and Environmental Protection determines that for any such 10 system that such use presents an environmentally responsible 11 alternative and that the requisite maintenance for such system is feasible 12 for the subject user.

(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, the Commissioner
of Energy and Environmental Protection may authorize the use of an
alternative treatment septic system for a commercial property or multi-

unit dwelling development if one or more of the requirements of subsection (a) of this section is not met but the commissioner determines that (1) such use is the most environmentally responsible solution for a subject user, (2) the requisite maintenance for such system will be undertaken by the subject user, and (3) such use will not result in the development of the subject property in a manner that could not occur without such use.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:Section 1October 1, 2020New section
