AN ACT CONCERNING "UPSKIRTING".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 53a-189a of the general statutes be amended to include
- 2 in the definition of voyeurism that a person is guilty of voyeurism
- 3 when with the intent to arouse or satisfy the sexual desire of such
- 4 person or any other person, such person knowingly photographs or
- 5 records an image of a person's body under or through his or her
- 6 clothing without the knowledge or consent of such other person.

Statement of Purpose:

To make it unlawful to take "upskirt" photos without consent even if the victim is in a public place.
