***AN ACT INCREASING THE QUALIFYING INCOME THRESHOLD  
LEVELS FOR THE CIRCUIT BREAKER TAX RELIEF PROGRAM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-170aa of the general statutes be amended to increase
- 2 the qualifying income threshold levels to forty-five thousand dollars
- 3 for unmarried homeowners and sixty thousand dollars for married
- 4 homeowners.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To increase the qualifying income threshold levels for the tax relief program under section 12-170aa of the general statutes to forty-five thousand dollars for unmarried homeowners and sixty thousand dollars for married homeowners.
