AN ACT CONCERNING LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS FOR ESTHETICIANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 20 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Department of Public Health to evaluate and make adjustments to the
- 3 licensure requirements for estheticians relative to employment
- 4 opportunities, salary scales and student loan indebtedness.
