AN ACT ELIMINATING THE LIMITATION PERIOD FOR BRINGING A CIVIL ACTION FOR CLAIMS ARISING FROM CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 52-577d of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that an action to recover damages for personal injury to a person under
- 3 twenty-one years of age, including emotional distress, caused by sexual
- 4 abuse, sexual exploitation or sexual assault may be brought by such
- 5 person at any time.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the limitation period for bringing a civil action arising from child sexual abuse.
