AN ACT ESTABLISHING A YOUTH SUICIDE PREVENTION PILOT PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Children and Families and the Office of the Child Advocate to establish
- 3 a youth suicide prevention pilot program to provide suicide prevention
- 4 training to school employees and employees of youth service bureaus,
- 5 youth-serving organizations, operators of youth athletic activities and
- 6 municipal social service agencies.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Children and Families and the Office of the Child Advocate to establish a youth suicide prevention pilot program.
