AN ACT ESTABLISHING PROTECTIONS FOR RESIDENTS FROM MOLD INFESTATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) establish a mold 2 protection advisory committee within the Department of Public Health 3 to advise the department and report to the joint standing committee of 4 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to public 5 health regarding mold infestation in residential housing, (2) require the 6 Department of Public Health to develop and adopt, in consultation with such advisory committee, (A) guidelines regarding permissible 8 exposure limits to mold in indoor environments, standards for assessing 9 the health threat from exposure to mold in indoor environments and 10 guidelines for identifying mold in indoor environments; (B) guidelines 11 for remediating mold in indoor environment; and (C) uniform 12 standards for mold assessment and remediation, (3) require the 13 imposition of penalties on a residential landlord when mold is found in 14 landlord's property under certain circumstances, (4) allow a credit 15 against the state income tax for owners of single-family and multifamily

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- residential properties who incur costs for certain mold remediation performed on the property, (5) authorize a tenant to deposit the tenant's rent in an escrow account if the tenant's landlord fails to comply with certain requirements related to mold remediation, and (6) prohibit a lessee from being evicted, the tenancy from being terminated and the rent from being raised for a lessee who seeks a remedy related to mold
- being found in the tenant's residence.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect residents from mold infestation.

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
