AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF INSTALLING BULLET-RESISTANT WINDOWS AND DOORS ON STATE AND MUNICIPAL POLICE PATROL VEHICLES.

- 1 That the Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection
- 2 be required to study and report to the General Assembly on the
- 3 feasibility of installing bullet-resistant windows and doors on state and
- 4 municipal police patrol vehicles.
