***AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A MEDICAL  
INTERDISTRICT MAGNET SCHOOL PROGRAM CURRICULUM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require the  
2 Departments of Education and Public Health and the Labor Department  
3 to jointly (1) develop a curriculum for a four-year high school level  
4 interdistrict magnet school program with special emphasis on medical  
5 studies that includes, but is not limited to, the following career  
6 pathways: (A) Certification upon graduation in health care professions  
7 such as licensed practical nurse, radiation technologist, ultrasound  
8 technologist, nursing aide or occupational therapist, and (B) biotech  
9 pathway for continued medical studies at an institution of higher  
10 education, and (2) review suitable locations for a facility to operate an  
11 interdistrict magnet school program with special emphasis on medical  
12 studies, such as on the campus of a regional community-technical  
13 college or a hospital, including, but not limited to, Windham Hospital.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To develop an interdistrict magnet school program with special emphasis on medical studies to allow students to enter a certified occupation within the health care field upon graduation or to pursue an advanced medical degree.
