AN ACT CONCERNING THE INSTRUCTION OF AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE IN SCHOOL IN CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to utilize available federal, state and local funding for the instruction of American Sign Language and to require that local and regional boards of education include American Sign Language courses in the course of study handbooks for the school district and offer such courses to students.

Statement of Purpose:

To facilitate the instruction of American Sign Language in school in Connecticut.
