AN ACT CONCERNING RETAILER POLICIES CONCERNING COMPROMISED DEBIT OR CREDIT CARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 21a of the general statutes be amended to prohibit any
- 2 retailer doing business in the state, including via the Internet, from
- 3 banning a consumer from shopping solely because a bank reported
- 4 false credit or debit card charges due to a compromised credit or debit
- 5 card, unless the retailer has a written company policy.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide transparency to consumers concerning company policies.
