AN ACT CONCERNING THE DONATION OF BLOOD BY MINORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 19a-285a of the general statutes be amended to allow
- 2 any person who is sixteen years of age to have the legal capacity to
- 3 donate blood or any component thereof and to consent to the
- 4 withdrawal of blood from his or her body in conjunction with any
- 5 voluntary blood donation program.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow any person who is sixteen years of age or older to donate blood.
