## AN ACT CONCERNING TRANSPORTATION PROJECT PRIORITIZATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective from passage) (a) Not later than December
- 2 1, 2019, and annually thereafter, the Commissioner of Transportation
- 3 shall report, in accordance with section 11-4a of the general statutes, to
- 4 the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
- 5 cognizance of matters relating to transportation, the status of
- 6 significant transportation projects in any phase of construction, design
- 7 or planning. This report shall be referred to as the "Transportation
- 8 Project Priority Report".
- 9 (b) The Transportation Project Priority Report shall: (1) Identify
- 10 twenty transportation projects that are a priority to the Department of
- 11 Transportation and for each identified transportation project, include
- 12 (A) whether such project is scheduled to be substantially complete by
- 13 the originally anticipated completion date, (B) whether the cost of such
- 14 project is under the budgeted amount and if not, identify the amount
- 15 that exceeds the budgeted amount and explain why such project
- 16 exceeded the budgeted amount, and (C) whether such project was

17 subject to a change order and if so, identify the cost of the change order 18 and explain the reason for the change order; (2) identify all 19 transportation projects that are at the stage where construction can 20 begin but such transportation projects are not funded; (3) identify all 21 transportation projects for which bonds have been authorized but 22 construction has not started and for each such transportation project, 23 identify (A) the date such bonds were authorized by the General 24 Assembly, (B) the reasons construction has not started, and (C) the 25 date construction is anticipated to start; and (4) identify all 26 transportation projects that are anticipated to become a priority based 27 on use, the demands of traffic and the integrity of the mode of 28 transportation.
