## AN ACT CONCERNING A FIRM HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION DATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-16*l* of the general statutes be amended to permit a
- 2 local or regional board of education to establish for any school year a
- 3 firm graduation date for students in grade twelve for that school year
- 4 which at the time of such establishment provides for at least one
- 5 hundred eighty days of school, and to eliminate the requirement that
- 6 such board establish a firm graduation date that is no earlier than the
- 7 one hundred eighty-fifth date noted in the school calendar originally
- 8 adopted by the board.

## Statement of Purpose:

To permit boards of education to establish and maintain a firm graduation date regardless of the cancellation of school days due to inclement weather or otherwise.
