AN ACT CONCERNING CRITICAL SKILLS IN DEMAND BY EMPLOYERS IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Office of

2 Workforce Strategy to (1) inventory critical skills that are in demand by

3 employers in the state, and (2) jointly with Charter Oak State College,

4 identify or develop a process of assessing and certifying such critical

5 skills.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Office of Workforce Strategy to provide a way to earn credentials for critical skills in demand by employers in the state.
