**AN ACT CONCERNING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER
ACCOUNTABILITY, STAKEHOLDER ROUNDTABLES AND FUNDING
FOR COMMUNITY POLICING PROGRAMS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) establish a system for
- 2 monitoring and addressing law enforcement officer misconduct, (2)
- 3 improve the responsiveness and accountability of law enforcement
- 4 officers to their communities by holding regularly scheduled roundtable
- 5 meetings with various stakeholders, and (3) increase funding for
- 6 community policing programs in order to build trust between law
- 7 enforcement officers and the communities they serve.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase public safety by building trust between law enforcement officers and the communities they serve and holding law enforcement officers accountable for their actions.
