AN ACT CONCERNING ABSENTEE BALLOTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to (1) specify that 2 absentee ballots may only be counted on the day of an election, (2) 3 provide consistency across all municipalities as to pre-election day 4 processing of absentee ballots, and (3) allow the registrars of voters to 5 contact electors for the purpose of curing unsigned absentee ballot 6 envelopes.

Statement of Purpose:

To specify that absentee ballots may only be counted on election day, provide consistency among towns as to pre-election processing of such ballots and allow for the curing of unsigned absentee ballot envelopes.
