AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF ISSUES RELATING TO EARLY COLLEGE AND DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Education shall 2 conduct a study of issues relating to student enrollment in, and 3 graduation from, middle college programs, early college high school 4 and Connecticut Early College Opportunity programs, as those terms are defined in section 31-11ff of the general statutes, and dual 5 6 enrollment programs. Such study shall include, but need not be 7 limited to, a review of how data relating to student enrollment in and 8 graduation from such programs is being reported by local and regional 9 boards of education and collected in the state-wide public school 10 information system pursuant to section 10-10a of the general statutes, 11 including whether such data concerning graduation from such 12 programs can be segregated at the school and district level from the 13 total graduation data at the school and district level. Not later than 14 January 1, 2020, the department shall submit a report on its findings 15 and any recommendations for legislation to the joint standing 16 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters 17 relating to education, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-18 4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
