AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO REVIEW VOLUNTARISM NEEDS OF THE STATE OMBUDSMAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a task force
- 2 to study ways to (1) ensure that the Office of the Long-Term Care
- 3 Ombudsman has enough volunteers to reach out to residents receiving
- 4 long-term care in nursing homes or from community-based programs,
- 5 and (2) help such residents to address complaints about their care.
- 6 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members:
- 7 (1) Two appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives,
- 8 both of whom shall be residents' advocates appointed pursuant to
- 9 section 17a-406 of the general statutes;
- 10 (2) Two appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate, both
- of whom shall be representatives of senior centers;
- 12 (3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of
- 13 Representatives;

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- 14 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate;
- 15 (5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of 16 Representatives;
- 17 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate;
- 18 (7) The State Ombudsman, or the State Ombudsman's designee;
- 19 (8) The Commissioner of Aging and Disability Services, or the 20 commissioner's designee;
- 21 (9) The Commissioner of Social Services, or the commissioner's 22 designee; and
- (10) The executive director of the Commission on Women, Children,
 Seniors, Equity and Opportunity, or the executive director's designee.
- 25 (c) Any member of the task force appointed under subdivision (3),
- 26 (4), (5) or (6) of subsection (b) of this section may be a member of the
- 27 General Assembly.
- 28 (d) All appointments to the task force shall be made not later than
- 29 thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy shall be
- 30 filled by the appointing authority.
- 31 (e) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president pro
- 32 tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the task force from
- among the members of the task force. Such chairpersons shall schedule
- 34 the first meeting of the task force, which shall be held not later than sixty
- 35 days after the effective date of this section.
- 36 (f) The administrative staff of the Commission on Women, Children,
- 37 Seniors, Equity and Opportunity shall serve as administrative staff of
- 38 the task force.
- 39 (g) Not later than January 1, 2022, the task force shall submit a report
- 40 on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing committees
- 41 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to aging

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- 42 and human services, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a
- of the general statutes. The task force shall terminate on the date that it
- submits such report or January 1, 2022, whichever is later.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
