AN ACT CONCERNING CAREER PATHWAYS AND WORKFORCE TRAINING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) require the Office of 2 Higher Education to (A) establish a rubric for career pathway training 3 programs; and (B) develop a new accelerated pathway to teacher 4 certification for people who work in the trades, (2) establish a task force 5 to examine any transportation barriers faced by participants in work-6 based learning programs, (3) require the Commissioner of Consumer 7 Protection to (A) adopt regulations pursuant to section 20-332 of the 8 general statutes to specify a journeyperson to apprentice ratio of two to 9 one for the period of July 1, 2023, until June 30, 2025, for the trades of 10 electrical, plumbing, heating, piping and cooling, sprinkler filter and 11 sheet metal work; and (B) jointly with the Labor Commissioner, (i) 12 increase fines for contractors who violate the journeyperson to 13 apprentice ratio, and (ii) develop and publish standards for exceptions 14 to the journeyperson to apprentice ratio requirement that accommodate

- 15 any workforce shortages, and (4) require the State Auditors of Public
- 16 Accounts to conduct an audit on the effectiveness of each workforce
- 17 development program funded by the state.

Statement of Purpose:

To develop a rubric for career pathway training programs and a new accelerated teacher certification pathway for people who work in the trades, establish a task force to examine transportation barriers related to work-based learning programs, amend the journeyperson to apprentice ratio until June 30, 2025, and require an audit of workforce development programs.
