AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY BACKUP POWER FOR CELL TOWERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2021) On or before October 1, 2022,
- 2 each telecommunications company, as defined in section 16-1 of the
- 3 general statutes, shall ensure that any free-standing telecommunications
- tower or antenna owned, leased or operated by such company contains 4
- 5 a backup power source sufficient to provide twenty-four consecutive
- 6 hours of service during an electric service outage.

Statement of Purpose:

To require a telecommunications company to provide backup power for free-standing telecommunications towers or antennas.
