AN ACT REVISING THE UNIFORM RELOCATION ASSISTANCE ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 135 of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 the Department of Housing, or any political entity of the state that the
- 3 Department of Housing may select, determine that a person is a
- 4 displaced person due to municipal code enforcement activities for
- 5 purposes of the Uniform Relocation Assistance Act.

Statement of Purpose:

To revise the Uniform Relocation Assistance Act to allow the Department of Housing or another political entity of the state, other than the municipality that issued the code violation, to determine that a resident has been displaced due to municipal code enforcement activities.
