Substitute Bill No. 923

AN ACT ALLOWING BEHAVIOR ANALYSTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROFESSIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR REGULATED PROFESSIONALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Subdivision (3) of subsection (a) of section 19a-12a of the
 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2019*):

(3) "Health care professionals" includes any person licensed or who
holds a permit pursuant to chapter 370, 372, 373, 375, 375a, 376, 376a,
376b, 376c, 377, 378, 379, 379a, 380, 381, 381a, <u>382a</u>, 383, 383a, 383b,
383c, 384, 384a, 384b, 384c, 384d, 385, 398 or 399;

8 Sec. 2. Subsection (b) of section 20-185k of the general statutes is 9 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July* 10 1, 2019, and applicable to applications for license renewal made on or after 11 July 1, 2019):

(b) A license issued under this section may be renewed annually. The license shall be renewed in accordance with the provisions of section 19a-88, for a fee of one hundred [seventy-five] <u>eighty</u> dollars for applications for renewal submitted on or after July 1, 2019. Each behavior analyst applying for license renewal shall furnish evidence satisfactory to the commissioner of having current certification with 18 the Behavior Analyst Certification Board.

- 19 Sec. 3. Section 19a-12d of the general statutes is repealed and the 20 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2019*):
- 21 On or before the last day of January, April, July and October in each 22 year, the Commissioner of Public Health shall certify the amount of 23 revenue received as a result of any fee increase in the amount of five dollars (1) that took effect October 1, 2015, pursuant to sections 19a-88, 24 25 19a-515, 20-65k, 20-74bb, 20-74h, 20-74s, 20-149, 20-162o, 20-162bb, 20-26 191a, 20-195c, 20-195o, 20-195cc, 20-201, 20-206b, 20-206n, 20-206r, 20-27 206bb, 20-206ll, 20-222a, 20-275, 20-395d, 20-398 and 20-412, and (2) 28 that took effect July 1, 2019, pursuant to section 20-185k, as amended 29 by this act, and transfer such amount to the professional assistance 30 program account established in section 19a-12c.
