

Substitute Bill No. 945

AN ACT CONCERNING THE INNOVATION INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR NONPROFIT PROVIDERS OF HUMAN SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 4-216 of the general statutes is
- 2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (Effective July
- 3 1, 2019):
- 4 (c) The secretary [may] shall establish [an] a pilot incentive program 5 for nonprofit providers of human services [whose contracts with the 6 state do not exceed one million dollars and who provide direct services 7 to not more than one hundred fifty persons enrolled in state-funded 8 assistance programs in specific geographical regions of the state. The incentive program may] that shall (1) allow providers who otherwise 10 meet contractual requirements to retain a percentage of any savings 11 realized by the providers from the contracted cost for services, (2) 12 require that at least fifty per cent of savings retained by the providers 13 be used to expand such services, and (3) provide that future contracted 14 amounts from the state for the same types of services are not reduced 15 solely to reflect savings achieved in previous contracts by such 16 providers. The pilot incentive program shall include eight nonprofit 17 providers of human services with state contracts of the following 18 amounts: (A) Two with contracts of at least fifty million dollars, (B) 19 two with contracts of at least twenty million dollars but less than fifty

- 20 million dollars, (C) two with contracts of at least five million dollars
- 21 <u>but less than twenty million dollars, and (D) two with contracts of less</u>
- 22 than five million dollars. For purposes of this subsection, ["state-
- 23 funded assistance programs"] "nonprofit providers of human services"
- 24 includes, but is not limited to, <u>nonprofit providers of</u> services
- 25 [provided] to persons with intellectual, physical or mental disabilities
- or autism spectrum disorder.
