AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF STANDARDS AND METHODS FOR PYRRHOTITE TESTING AT QUARRIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective July 1, 2019) The Commissioner of Consumer
- 2 Protection shall study standards and methods used at quarries for the
- 3 testing of concrete aggregate for the presence of pyrrhotite. Such study
- 4 shall include, but need not be limited to, an evaluation of standards
- 5 and methods published by the United States Army Corps of Engineers,
- 6 National Institute of Standards and Technology and ASTM
- 7 International. Not later than January 1, 2020, the Commissioner of
- 8 Consumer Protection shall submit a report, in accordance with the
- 9 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing
- 10 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
- 11 relating to insurance and planning and development. Such report shall
- include, but need not be limited to, the findings of such study and any
- 13 recommendations for legislation.
