## AN ACT ALLOWING ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSES AND PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS TO ISSUE HOME HEALTH ORDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 19a-496a of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2021*):
- 3 (a) All home health care agency, hospice home health care agency and
- 4 home health aide agency services shall be performed upon the order of
- 5 <u>a physician licensed pursuant to chapter 370, a physician assistant</u>
- 6 licensed pursuant to chapter 370 or an advanced practice registered
- 7 <u>nurse licensed pursuant to chapter 378.</u>
- 8 (b) All home health care agency, hospice home health care agency 9 and home health aide agency services [which] that are required by law 10 to be performed upon the order of a licensed physician, physician 11 assistant or advanced practice registered nurse may be performed upon 12 the order of a physician, a physician assistant or an advanced practice 13 registered nurse licensed in a state [which] that borders Connecticut.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
