## AN ACT CONCERNING PETROLEUM STORAGE LEVELS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) The Commissioner of Energy and
- 2 Environmental Protection shall conduct a study regarding the state's
- 3 adoption of hedging strategies to mitigate against the risk of a
- 4 petroleum shortage in the state. Such study shall include, but need not
- 5 be limited to, (1) an examination of any necessary legislation to enable
- 6 the state to participate in the petroleum market to prevent petroleum
- 7 shortages, and (2) methods by which the state can provide a hedge that
- 8 would ensure an adequate supply of petroleum for use by residents for
- 9 home heating and by power plants for the generation of electricity. Not
- 10 later than February 1, 2024, the commissioner shall report, in accordance
- with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, the results of
- 12 such study to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
- 13 having cognizance of matters relating to energy and technology.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
