## AN ACT AMENDING THE CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN PARCELS OF STATE LAND IN THE TOWN OF MANSFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3 of special act 89-54 is amended to read as
- 2 follows (*Effective from passage*):
- 3 (a) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes to the
- 4 contrary, the [commissioner of mental retardation] Commissioner of
- 5 <u>Developmental Services</u> shall convey to the town of Mansfield, subject
- 6 to the approval of the [state properties review board] State Properties
- 7 Review Board and at a cost equal to the administrative costs of making
- 8 such conveyance, two parcels of land located in the town of Mansfield,
- 9 having a total area of approximately 16 acres. The first parcel of land
- 10 contains approximately 15.6 acres, is a portion of a larger parcel
- 11 conveyed to the state of Connecticut by William P. Kelley and
- 12 recorded in the Mansfield Land Records at Volume 47, Page 227 and is
- the same property shown on a map entitled "Map Showing Land of the

- 14 State of Connecticut to be Acquired by the Town of Mansfield" dated 15 December 1988, scale 1" = 40 feet, 2 sheets certified A-2 by Grant 16 Meitzler, RLS #10,005, which map is filed in the Mansfield Land 17 Records. Said parcel of land shall be conveyed subject to an access 18 easement of record in favor of Raymond E. and Marianne Gergler, 19 which is of unspecified width giving a right to pass over said parcel 20 from a point near the top of the hill (at land of Gergler) to Depot Road. 21 The second parcel of land is a triangular parcel of land located 22 westerly of the southwesterly corner of land of Gergler, easterly of the 23 Central Vermont Railroad Company land, and northerly of the 24 northwesterly corner of the first parcel herein described and is the 25 same property shown on a map entitled "Map Showing Land of State 26 of Connecticut to be acquired by the Town of Mansfield", dated 27 January 1989, scale 1" = 20 feet, sheet 2-A of 2, certified Class D by 28 Grant Meitzler, RLS #10,005, which map is to be filed in the Mansfield 29 [land records] Land Records. The conveyance of said parcels of land 30 shall include transfer of rights to the abandoned railroad siding on said 31 parcels to the town of Mansfield, and the right to the use of the existing 32 sewer line, water line, and utility lines located on Connecticut Light 33 and Power Company poles 21, 22, 23 and 24, on terms negotiated by 34 [commissioner of mental retardation Commissioner of 35 Developmental Services and the town of Mansfield. The locations of 36 such utility service lines are shown on the above referenced map 37 showing the first parcel of land herein described.
- 38 (b) The town of Mansfield shall use said parcels of land for [a day 39 care facility] <u>municipal purposes</u> and shall compensate the state of 40 Connecticut for [such facility's] use of the utilities and services of the 41 Mansfield Training School. If [said parcels are not used for such 42 purpose, the parcels shall revert to the state of Connecticut.] <u>the town</u> of Mansfield:
- 44 (1) Does not use said parcels for said purposes;
- 45 (2) Does not retain ownership of all of said parcels; or

- 46 (3) Leases all or any portion of said parcels, other than a lease for municipal purposes,
- 48 <u>the parcels shall revert to the state of Connecticut.</u>
- 49 (c) The [state properties review board] State Properties Review 50 Board shall complete its review of the conveyance of said parcels of 51 land not later [that] than thirty days after it receives a proposed 52 agreement from the commissioner of mental retardation] 53 Commissioner of Developmental Services. The land shall remain 54 under the care and control of said commissioner until a conveyance is 55 made in accordance with the provisions of this section. The [state 56 treasurer State Treasurer shall execute and deliver any deed or 57 instrument necessary for a conveyance under this section and the 58 [commissioner of public works] Commissioner of Administrative 59 Services shall have the sole responsibility for all other incidents of such 60 conveyance.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
