AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS CENTER PILOT PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective July 1, 2023) (a) The Department of Mental
- 2 Health and Addiction Services, in consultation with the Department of
- 3 Children and Families, shall establish a mental health crisis center pilot
- 4 program in one region of the state to be determined by the
- 5 Commissioner of Mental Health and Addiction Services for the
- 6 purpose of enhancing mental health outcomes for persons
- experiencing a mental health crisis by redirecting such persons away
- 8 from the hospital emergency department and toward a facility
- 9 dedicated to the provision of mental health services to persons in
- 10 crisis. The Commissioner of Mental Health and Addiction Services
- shall establish the pilot program in accordance with such terms and
- 12 conditions as the commissioner may prescribe.
- (b) Not later than January 1, 2024, the commissioner shall report, in
 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
 cognizance of matters relating to public health regarding the success of

- 17 the pilot program in serving persons experiencing a mental health
- 18 crisis and any recommendations for continuing the pilot program or
- 19 expanding the pilot program into other communities in the state.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
