RESOLUTION PROPOSING A STATE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO PROVIDE FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF CONTESTED GENERAL ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 Section 1. That the following be proposed as an amendment to the
- 2 Constitution of the State, which, when approved and adopted in the
- 3 manner provided by the Constitution, shall, to all intents and purposes,
- 4 become a part thereof:
- 5 Section 7 of article third of the Constitution is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 7. The treasurer, secretary of the state, and comptroller shall
- 8 canvass publicly the votes for senators and representatives. The person
- 9 in each senatorial district having the greatest number of votes for
- senator shall be declared to be duly elected for such district, and the
- person in each assembly district having the greatest number of votes for
- 12 representative shall be declared to be duly elected for such district. The
- general assembly shall provide by law the manner in which an equal
- and the greatest number of votes for two or more persons so voted for

15 senator or representative shall be resolved. The return of votes, and the 16 result of the canvass, shall be submitted to the house of representatives, 17 [and] to the senate and to the supreme court on the first day of the 18 session of the general assembly. [Each house shall be the final judge of 19 the election returns and qualifications of its own members] The judicial 20 department shall have exclusive jurisdiction to adjudicate disputes or 21 questions regarding the election return of members of the general 22 assembly.

RESOLVED: That the foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitution be continued to the next session of the General Assembly elected at the general election to be held on November 5, 2024, and published with the laws passed at the present session, or be presented to the electors at the general election to be held on November 5, 2024, whichever the case may be, according to article sixth of the amendments to the Constitution. The designation of said proposed amendment to be used on the ballots at such election shall be "Shall the Constitution of the State be amended to provide for judicial review of disputes and questions regarding elections to the General Assembly?"
