RESOLUTION AMENDING THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO PROHIBIT LEGISLATIVE LIAISONS FROM THE HOUSE AND SENATE FLOOR DURING SESSIONS.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That article third of the Constitution of the state be amended to
- 2 prohibit legislative liaisons employed by an executive branch agency or
- 3 a legislative commission from the floor of (1) the House on a day when
- 4 the House is in session, or (2) the Senate on a day when the Senate is in
- 5 session, except for a public hearing on the floor of the House or Senate
- 6 or a liaison invited to the floor of the House or Senate for purposes of a
- 7 ceremony or recognition.

Statement of Purpose:

To subject agency liaisons to the same rules as lobbyists regarding their presence on the House and Senate floor.
