Sec. 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the

1 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as  
2 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December  
3 24, 1973 (87 Stat, 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of  
4 Columbia Register.

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
