A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

---

To establish Office of Motion Picture and Television Development and to require that the Mayoral nomination of the Director of Office of Motion Picture and Television Development be subject to the affirmative approval of the Council.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Office of Motion Picture and Television Development Director Confirmation Act of 2014".

Sec 2. The Office of Motion Picture and Television Development, established by Mayor's Order 79-218, dated September 14, 1979, shall be headed by a Director appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council pursuant section 2(a) of the District of Columbia Confirmation Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-142; D.C. Official Code § 1-523.01(a).

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

Sec. 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
