
Dear Chairman Mendelson:

Enclosed for consideration and approval by the Council of the District of Columbia is the "Pepco Cost-Sharing Fund For DC PLUG Establishment Act of 2014" (bill), along with an accompanying emergency declaration resolution and temporary and permanent versions of the bill. The bill will establish a special purpose revenue fund, wherein the District Department of Transportation ("DDOT") may deposit funds received from Potomac Electric Power Company ("Pepco") as reimbursement for cost-sharing obligations associated with the District of Columbia Power Line Undergrounding, also known, as DC PLUG, initiative. It is anticipated that Pepco and DDOT will cover the cost of DC PLUG equitably, and in order to achieve an equitable cost-sharing arrangement, Pepco will reimburse DDOT for certain costs associated with DC PLUG. This special purpose revenue fund is necessary so that DDOT has a mechanism in place to receive these funds from Pepco and to dedicate these funds solely for DC PLUG.


I urge the Council to take prompt and favorable action on this proposed legislation.

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11 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
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14 Chairman Phil Mendelson, at the request of the Mayor, introduced the following bill, which was
15 referred to the Committee on the Whole.
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17 To establish a special purpose fund, separate and apart from the General Fund, into which DDOT
18 shall deposit funds received from Potomac Electric Power Company, for which said
19 funds shall be used solely for any permitted purposes authorized by Chapter 13A of
20 Subtitle III of Title 34 for the District of Columbia Power Line Undergrounding, also
21 known as DC PLUG, initiative.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
24 act may be cited as the “Pepco Cost-Sharing Fund for DC PLUG Establishment Act of 2014”.

25 Sec. 2. There is hereby established the Pepco Cost-Sharing Fund for DC PLUG (“Fund”)
26 as a non-lapsing, revolving special purpose revenue fund.

27 (a) The funds deposited into the Fund, and any interest earned on those funds, shall
28 not revert to the unrestricted fund balance of the General Fund at the end of the fiscal year, or at
29 any other time.

30 (b) The Fund shall be administered by the Director of the District Department of
31 Transportation and shall be used to pay for any permitted purpose authorized by Chapter 13A of
32 Subtitle III of Title 34 for the District of Columbia Power Line Undergrounding, also known as
33 DC PLUG, initiative.

34 (c) The following shall be deposited in the Fund:

1 1. Transfers from the Potomac Electric Power Company to facilitate cost-sharing
2 for DC PLUG.

3 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

4 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statements in the committee report as the fiscal
5 impact statements required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
6 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code §1-206.02(c)(3)).

7 Sec. 4. Effective date.

8 This act shall take effect following the approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
9 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review
10 as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
11 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code §1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
12 Columbia Register.


